✓	Conduct the appropriate research on your industry, target market and competition.
✓	Develop a business plan.
✓	Determine your company's business structure.
✓	Choose and register your business name.
	 Proprietorships or Partnerships need to contact the Office of the Register of Deeds in the county/counties where the business will operate. Corporations and LLCs should contact the Corporations Division to reserve its business name.
✓	Contact the North Carolina Secretary of State's Corporations Division to determine if your business is subject to any sate licensing.
✓	Obtain a Mecklenburg County Tax License, which is required for anyone doing business in Mecklenburg County.
✓	Contact the city/county to obtain any necessary occupational licenses and/or permits.
✓	Verify any operating restrictions that your business location may have; for example, Homeowners Associations Codes, Covenants and Restrictions and city/county zoning laws.
✓	If necessary, acquire a Federal Employer Identification Number.
✓	If you have or plan to have employees, familiarize yourself with state and federal labor regulations.
✓	Explore any necessary financing options for your business.
✓	Meet with an accountant, attorney and insurance agent to ensure your business' success.
